You are entering a Seveso-classified chemical site!

The instructions in this leaflet are designed to ensure your own safety, as well as that of other people on the site. By entering our premises, you undertake to comply with them. Failure to comply with the safety instructions may result in the offender being denied access to the site.



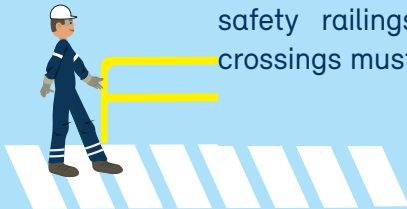

SITE ACCESS



Accompanying persons are not authorized to access the site (except trainers). It is forbidden to stay on the site longer than necessary. Accompanying animals are not allowed on site.

TRAFFIC



It is forbidden to circulate alone on the site, to run and to lean or climb on the safety railings. Pedestrian crossings must be used.

ALCOHOL & DRUGS



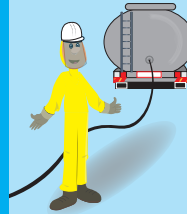
Smoking is permitted only in smoking areas. It is forbidden to bring alcoholic beverages, drugs or weapons onto the site.

STANDARD PPES



Helmets, safety shoes and goggles, long-legged and long-sleeved clothing and high-visibility clothing must be worn on site. Gloves are now mandatory. Hearing protection must also be readily available.

SPECIFIC PPES



Depending on the specific risks associated with the product you are loading or unloading, additional equipment may be required. Follow the posted instructions and the instructions of your Rosier contact.

LOADING / UNLOADING



All loading and unloading is carried out under the authority of a Rosier employee. Under no circumstances are you authorized to operate without prior authorization. Follow posted instructions and application procedures for the operations you carry out.

HYGIENE



Sanitary facilities are available at the entrance and on site. Please respect these areas as you should. Think of those who come after you !

ENVIRONMENT



Garbage cans are at your disposal. Please use them and respect selective sorting! Any unauthorized dumping of products is prohibited. Vehicle cleaning requires prior authorization from the Industrial Department.

ALERT / ALARM



In the event of a general alarm (siren), listen carefully to the message delivered by your Rosier contact and/or evacuate to the nearest emergency evacuation area (see site map) after stopping and securing your loading/unloading operation.



- The highway code applies on site, so please obey the signs.
- Rosier machines have priority over other vehicles.
- Overtaking is forbidden. Maintain a minimum distance of 10 meters from the vehicle in front.
- Do not park outside the designated areas.
- Do not allow anyone on the running boards of your vehicle.
- It is forbidden to drive with a raised skip or tank.
- Keep traffic areas clear and do not obstruct passageways.

Notify your Rosier contact of any anomaly.
